## OPENING HYMN: O Christ, the Healer, We Have Come No. 638

**CLOSING HYMN: When Our Confidence Is Shaken**

**No. 413**

1. When our confidence is shaken in the beliefs we thought secure, when the spirit in its sickness seeks but cannot find a cure, God is active in the tensions of a faith not yet mature, of a faith not yet mature.
